

Note date change: generators and chillers operating until 1/17/12

Jam Entertainment and Creative Services, promoters for Red Bull Crashed Ice, have applied for a sound level variance for the 24/7 operation of chillers and generators from 12/26/11 to 1/17/12, and the use of an amplified sound system for the event on 1/11/12 through 1/14/12 from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Noise sources will be located near an enclosed track that will run from the open space to the North of the St. Paul Cathedral and East of 231 Dayton Ave. and terminate in the park area near the intersection of Old Kellogg Blvd. and College Ave.

Conditions:

- ① All ~~speakers~~ speaker locations will be limited to 95 dBA as measured 80 feet from the ~~speakers~~ sound source from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Jan 11, 2012 through Jan 14, 2012
- ② All chillers and generators will be limited to 80 dBA as measured 15 feet from the sound source, from Dec 26, 2011 through Jan 17, 2012
