Think Before You Click: This email originated outside our organization.

Molly this is Vicky from feline rescue outreach program. Wanted to give you an update on 134 Case Avenue with Gordon Anderson who goes by the name John and is 81 years old. We got six cats out last week. I know the animal control officer said they were going to check back and to keep going, I believe that's what John said. It's going a little bit slower because we have to get them fixed and have to have spots to get them fixed and also have to find Foster Caregivers for some of them. But I was there last night and I believe there's about five in the Caged in area that are supposed to be males and then they can also go into the basement. And there is approximately 5 outside that some you could see and some he said were supposed to be out there but I did not see. And I believe we've taken 25 to 30 cats out of there.. so we are still doing well with getting the six out last week and when we get some more room and some spots to get them fixed we will grab some more.

And it looks a lot less crowded around their than when we started ... definitely

Thanks, just wanted to give you an update of how things are going. He keeps mentioning getting the three back at some point and when that becomes a reality of us getting these cats all fixed and looking for placement for them then I will speak to you more seriously about if we have to give them back to him. Right now they are in a foster home and we know which three they are and they are girls. Of course we have absorbed all the cost for getting them fixed and getting them up to date on shots and Revolution a couple times and worming them, so I don't know if we could use the argument that here are the charges for the cats if you want them back. He knew about the Frogtown free cat fixing project a few years ago and he did nothing. So as with most people in this situation he is not very responsible but yet he wants us to give them back to him when we have spent a lot of money on these three cats as well as the rest of them that were in his house and on his property. And he definitely is not taking any responsibility other than to feed them and give them some shelter and let them run on the streets to get pregnant or poop on somebody's property who gets mad at him, or hit by a car or spread the fleas all around the neighborhood. They may be what he said keeps him going but unfortunately the cats have not been able to keep going at a healthy pace because he's done nothing to help them much except feed them and most of that he gets from a couple different resources for people who are low-income. And when I saw him last night he had just come from the Union Gospel and got free food for himself and I know he has other resources where they bring him some free food. So why should he have animals if he can't even afford to take care of himself. One cat he brought to his friends in Coon Rapids, it had four or five stores down its back. I asked him if they were going to bring it to the vet and he didn't know. A friend of mine said it could be brought there and thinking about it these or certainly look like it could be where the tubercle worm is by what I recall the
