Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 24, 2011, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A re-inspection will be made on November 15, 2011 at 11:00 am or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 2. Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the windows in good condition.-Repair deteriorated glazing putty as needed throughout exterior. Putty was noted to be chipped, crumbling or missing on multiple windows.
- 3. Upper Unit Living Room SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.
- 4. Upper Unit Side Bedroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Paint the ceiling and wall where water-stained.
