Your building was inspected on September 29, 2010 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

### A re-inspection will be made on November 9, 2010 at 1:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**



Basement - MSFC 605.1 -Provide a grounding jumper around the water meter. -Repair clamp.



Exterior - Rear - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the door frame.

3. Exterior - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.



Exterior - MSFC 605.1 - Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. - Contact a licensed electrician to repair and properly install exposed wire used for air conditioner power supply.

Exterior - MSFC 504.2 - Provide 'DOOR BLOCKED' sign on the exterior of all doors which have been rendered nonfunctional or are blocked by interior storage. Letters shall be at least 6 inches high and of contrasting color to the background.

-Permanently block and label door or install an exterior step per code.



Interior - MSFC 605.5 - Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.



Interior - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the window sash. -Repair damaged sash cords.



Interior - MSFC 605.4 - Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-Living Room.

- 9. Interior MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)-266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.
  - -All three main floor bedroom's (East, Middle, and West) egress windows measure 21 inches height by 34.5 inches width openable space and have a glazed area of 10.6 square feet.
- Interior MSFC 605.4.1, MSFC 605.4.2 Relocatable power taps shall be of the polarized or grounded type, equipped with overcurrent protection, and shall be listed in accordance with UL 1363. Relocatable power taps shall be directly connected to a permanently installed receptacle.
- 11. Interior NFPA 211, 9-2 Have the chimneys, fireplaces, and vents inspected for soundness, freedom from deposits, and correct clearances. Cleaning, maintenance, and repairs shall be done if indicated by the inspection.
- 12. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 13. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
