Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above project. It is being reviewed pursuant to the responsibilities given the State Historic Preservation Officer by the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and implementing federal regulations at 36 CFR 800, and to the responsibilities given the Minnesota Historical Society by the Minnesota Historic Sites Act.

The above property is not listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Moreover, we do not find that it has been demonstrated to meet the criteria for listing. Therefore, based on information that is available at this time, we conclude that **no properties** eligible for or listed in the National Register of Historic Places will be affected by this project.

However, we do note that the building is located in the locally designated Dayton's Bluff Historic District, and we urge that the advice of the St. Paul Heritage Preservation Commission be sought in reference to what impact this demolition may have on the District.
