The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on March 16, 2018 and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

- 1. Vehicles/Boats/Trailers parked on an unapproved parking surface. Remove, and file a site plan with Zoning for parking spaces in the yard. PLEASE REMOVE VEHICLES PARKED IN GRASS INCLUDING THE TAN BUICK 344JHT 03/18 AND THE WHITE FORD 798XVW 08/18.
- 2. All vehicles must be correctly licensed, operable, secure from unauthorized entry, and parked on an improved surface. Correct violations; store in a garage or remove. PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL VEHICLES HAVE CURRENT TABS INCLUDING THE TAN BUICK 011XBT PARKED IN THE DRIVEWAY. UPON RE-INSPECTION VEHICLES UNDER THE TARP WILL BE TOWED IF THEY ARE NOT IN COMPLIANCE.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after March 29, 2018, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)
