**Noise Source:** Team Ortho Foundation has requested a sound level variance to provide music and announcements and the use of a mobile DJ sound system for runners for the Monster Dash Event. The variance is requested for 80 dBA at 50 feet for the hours of 9:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 8:45 a.m. for the Shepard Road, Washington to Eagle Area; from 8:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:45 a.m. for the Eagle Pkwy, Shepard to Chestnut Area, and from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:45 a.m. for the Upper Landing Park site on Saturday, October 31, 2015. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 8:45 a.m. for the Shepard Road, Washington to Eagle Area, from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:45 a.m. for the Eagle Pkwy, Shepard to Chestnut Area and from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 7:45 a.m. for the Upper Landing Park site on Saturday, October 31, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and/or announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 2:30 p.m. on the date of the event.
