Adult diapers on the floor and in garbage bag not taken out, moldy food on the floor and counter, strong odor of human and cat yearn/feces.
- 2. Interior Unit 6- Throughout MSFC 315.3 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.
- 3. Interior Unit 6-Throughout SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.34 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.
