The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

- 2nd Floor Hallway SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass. 2.
- 2nd Floor Hallway SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.
- 2nd Floor North and West bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed An Equal Opportunity Employer

area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Double hung window openings.

Height 21 in - Width 25 in.

Glazed area.

Height 44.5 in. - Width 21.5 in.

- 5. Basement stairs SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate ballustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 6. Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Scrape and paint garage.
