



Stage Orientations

Main Stage (yellow box)

Main stage reorientated from 2024 to face toward the physical stadium structure so that the majority of sound is hitting the stadium, not traveling toward the highway. Red arrow representing the direction of sound.


Second Stage (pink box)

Second stage remaining in the same location as 2024, sending sound directly at the stadium. Red arrow representing the direction of sound.

Low Frequency (Bass) Sound Mitigation

Cardioid Sub Array Arrangement

Cardioid sub array arrangement is where you aim one sub in each stack backwards and the sound waves cancel each other out so you don't get so much sub bass going out the back of the stage. Mitigating low frequency, or bass sounds, firing backwards toward the rear of the stages.
