Dear Property Representative: All work to be done on appointment date or appeal filed. Enforcement action will be taken if all deficiencies are not accountable.

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on October 21, 2010. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on January 19, 2011 at 12:30 P.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Front Steps attached to public sidewalk SPLC SEC 34.09 Stairs steps deemed hazardous by the enforcement officer shall be corrected so as to be in compliance with the building code.
- 2. House SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the carpeting. Carpet has been removed. Where carpet has been removed the floor must be done in a professional manner.
- 3. SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.
- 4. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.
