Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Remove open insulation and plastic on walls in the basement or sheetrock per code.
 - 2. MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.- Windows measured:

Basement: 19H x 35W (1)

Upper Bedrooms: 20H x 39W (3)

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
