NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND LICENSE

Troy Jackson Troyco Concrete & Masonry Inc. 9657 Credit River Boulevard Prior Lake, MN 55372

Trade-Concrete Masonry & Finish Cement license held by Troyco Concrete & Masonry Inc. d/b/a Troyco Concrete & Masonry Inc. for the City of Saint Paul License ID #00TR1316

Dear Mr. Jackson:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended suspension of the Trade-Concrete Masonry & Finish Cement license held by Troyco Concrete & Masonry Inc. d/b/a Troyco Concrete & Masonry Inc. for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On October 7, 2011 you were sent a letter and RENEWAL INVOICE from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) indicating that your Trade-Concrete Masonry & Finish Cement license had expired as of July 6, 2011. You currently owe \$267.00 in delinquent license and late fees.

You were also asked to submit a current certificate of General Liability insurance with a 30-day notice of cancellation and current bond and Master Cardholder information. You were given until October 28, 2011, to submit the payment and requested information. As of today's date, neither has been received.

In addition to the suspension of your Trade-Concrete Masonry & Finish Cement license, pursuant to Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office will also recommend a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit the required information in order to maintain your license.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

1. You can submit the requested information. If this is your choice, you should send the information directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday**, **December 26**, 2011. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Payment of the delinquent license and late fees and submission of the requested information will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.

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- 2. If you wish to <u>admit</u> the facts but contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council, you will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting the facts and requesting a public hearing. We will need to receive your letter by **Monday, December 26, 2011**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to suspend your license and impose the \$500.00 matrix penalty. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 3. If you no longer wish to do business in the City of Saint Paul, you will need to send a written statement to that effect to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday**, **December 26**, 2011. Information should be directed to the attention of Christine Rozek.

If you have not contacted me by Monday, December 26, 2011, I will assume that you do not contest the suspension of your license and imposition of the \$500.00 matrix penalty. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
