I have received a notice from the Department of Safety and Inspections during a recent Certificate of Occupancy inspection that the windows in each bedroom at 210 Otis Ave did not meet the required egress.

I have included a copy of the report which indicates all of the sizes and the glazed area square feet. All of the windows do not meet the height requirement, but do meet the width requirement and in some instances even exceeds the requirement.

We respectfully request we be granted a variance for this property because the opening is very close to the 5 square feet required.

Your building was inspected on December 23, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A re-inspection will be made on January 26, 2012 at 11:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Double hung windows - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-

- 2. Unit 2 West bedroom MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove and discontinue excessive storage of clothes on floor.
- 3. Unit 3 MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 4. Unit 3 MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 5. Unit 4 Rear door MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove diswasher and maintain exitway free from obstructions.
- 6. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Remove unapproved tape from the dryer vent.
- 7. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
