Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at 692 SIXTH STREET EAST

Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on June 10, 2025, Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond continued the matter to Legislative Hearing on **Tuesday**, **June 24, 2025 at 9 am in room 330 City Hall/Courthouse** (15 W. Kellogg Blvd) for further discussion after your review of options for property.

## For your reference, the following items would eventually need to be completed before receiving a grant of time from the City Council to rehabilitate the property:

- 1. If you are intending to have a third party rehabilitate the property, pending transfer of title, the contract used for this transaction will need to be approved by the Legislative Hearing Officer. Please note that title cannot transfer until the rehabilitation is complete and nuisance abated;
- 2. \$5,000 Performance Deposit posted with the Department of Safety & Inspections;
- 3. apply for a Code Compliance inspection with the Department of Safety & Inspections;
- **4. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation.** Staff estimates costs to exceed \$150,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis:
- 5. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued;
- **6. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids which address all items in the Code Compliance Inspection Report and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and
- 7. the property must be maintained.
