<b>Synopsis :</b> <p>On 12/29/2024 at 0127 hours Officers were dispatched to 733 Carroll Avenue for reports that an unknown male had just broken a window into the house before fleeing. An investigation was made, DNA was collected and a report was written.</p>		
<b>Narrative :</b> <p>On 12/29/2024 at 0127 hours I, officer T. Lewis (SQD 122) was dispatched to 733 Carroll Avenue for reports that an unknown party had just broken a window into the house. CAD comments stated</p> <div></div> <p>Officers arrived on scene. While squads conducted an area check I spoke with caller at the address Cox, Carolyn Ruth (DOB/1965-01-10). COX appeared shaken.</p> <p>COX stated the following: She was sleeping on the downstairs couch tonight. She heard a banging noise that woke her up. Her dog was attentive and appeared disturbed by the noise. She then heard a window shatter on the ground level north side (rear) of the house. The dog began barking. She ran upstairs in the address. She then called 911 and looked out a north facing window. She saw a male party jump the chain link fence into the backyard of 732 Concordia Avenue fleeing northbound. She stated the male party appeared to be approximately 6' 1" in all black with a hood up. She was unable to get any additional details.</p> <p>The house was cleared. A bedroom window was found broken on the north side ground level of the house. While inspecting the broken window I discovered fresh smudged bloody fingerprints on the glass. Pictures of the window were taken and uploaded to axon capture. I donned a face mask and nitride gloves, and collected samples of the blood using the department issued DNA collection kit.</p> <p>It should be noted that the rear of the address has an 8 foot tall wooden privacy fence surrounding it. It appeared that two boards had been recently pulled from the fence. The manner of the damage</p>

appeared as if someone had either pulled on them while going over the fence, or pushed off of them while jumping over the fence. Pictures of this damage was additionally uploaded to axon capture.

When COX was shown the damage to the fence she stated that may have been the noise she heard, when she was woken up.

COX was unable to secure the window, a board up crew was called and secured the window.

COX was given a business card with the case number.

Sergeant Tereshko was briefed on the call.
