**Noise Source:** Minnesota Public Radio, Fred Shepherd, Event Architects, Event Producer has requested a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 96 dBA at 50 feet to 100 feet, to provide the use of amplified sound and announcements at the Stage #1 Location, Landmark Plaza by Market Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Street, for the 2017 MPR 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Street Dance. The variance is requested for the hours of 3:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 7, 2017. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) the Variance shall be for the hours of 3:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. for the MPR 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Street Dance Event on Saturday, October 7, 2017 at Stage #1, Landmark Plaza by Market Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Street. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 96 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source used for music and announcements. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 10:00 p.m. on the date of the event.

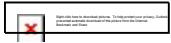

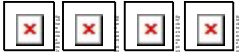
