NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Red Bull Crashed Ice 2016 Sound Level Variance

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Locations: Event will be located along John Ireland Boulevard, in or near North Cathedral Hill Park, Monument Park, Cathedral Hill Park, South Cathedral Hill Park and Arch Park.

Noise Source: Hangman Productions, Inc. has applied for a sound level variance in order to allow 24/7 operation of chillers and generators beginning Tuesday, February 2, 2016 through Monday, March 7, 2016 and the use of an amplified sound system between the hours of 4:00 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. for the Red Bull Crashed Ice event, to be held on Wednesday, February 24, 2016, through Saturday, February 27, 2016, with pre-event sound checks at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 24, 2016 and pre-event sound checks from 2:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. Thursday, February 25, 2016 through Saturday, February 27, 2016. Applicant has indicated that chillers and generators used for the event will not exceed 80 decibels at 15 feet and speakers will not exceed 95 decibels at 80 feet.
