Location: 1075 Third Street East

Noise Source: Target Corporation, represented by Stacey Hartung, Construction Project Manager, has requested a sound level variance, at a requested sound level of 85 decibels (dBA) at no specified distance for construction work related to demolition of existing pavement and tree removal using various pieces of equipment at the American Indian Magnet School, 1075 Third Street East. The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) will be recommending the following conditions: 1.) The variance will be for construction and work, using various pieces of equipment, including excavator, front end loader, grader, chain saw, dump trucks, etc. beginning August 4, 2016 through August 12, 2016. 2.) Work periods will be restricted to Monday through Friday, beginning at 7:00 a.m. and ending at 5:00 p.m. 3.) The contractors working on the project will use best practicable methods for controlling noise, such as, but not limited to, limiting usage of loud equipment to minimal time, lower noise emitting techniques, noise blankets, shields or portable sound barriers. Construction activities will be scheduled to minimize noise as much as possible in the evening and early morning hours. Equipment should be fitted with manufacturer's approved exhaust mufflers.
