NARRATIVE

On 01/01/2012 at 0259 hours, Squad 219 (J. Korus) responded to 201 W. 7th on a report of a broken window. The complainant was a passerby who stated the front window had been broken out.

I arrived on scene and observed a store front window with a hole in it. The glass was cracked around it. The front door of the building was secured and I determined at this time, no one made entry into the business.

Dispatch was unable to contact a key holder for the business or neighboring business. I called for a board up crew. Due to the size of the hole and that it did not appear to be an attempted burglary at this time, I did not wait for the board up crew to arrive on scene.

NARRATIVE

Sqd 257 (Wroblewski) responded to a CDP call at 201 W 7th St. A customer of the Eagle St Grille reported the storefront window at Nevermind Gallery was damaged. Upon my arrival I saw that the large (@ 4.5 by 3.5 foot) storefront window to the right of the entry door had been broken. There was a sizable hole in the window and the glass was spiderwebbed.

There had been no report made at this address per the Comm Center. I phoned the number posted on the gallery sign and the owner - K "Jit" Bhatia (w/p 292-1623) - responded and met me out front. Bhatia - who owns numerous buildings in the city - told me that the damage occurred sometime between 2100 hrs on 12-30-11 and 1000 hrs on 12-31-11. He suspected it happened over night and said that his son told him he heard a noise out front at @ 0200 hrs that night. Bhatia told me he had taken numerous photos of the damaged window. He didn't report it until I called him because he figured we - the police - would be quite busy over the holiday. Bhatia was given a card with CN.
