I regret not being able to attend the hearing on Jan. 10th, and I apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Hopefully, my absence won't delay the recent progress being made on the duplex at 688 E. 6th St. I have designated Bill Barnett, a friend and associate, as my Power of Attorney representative. Bill is a Realtor with Stevens Realty in St. Paul.

My intent with this property is to get a Certificate of Occupancy and Code Compliance as soon as possible, which will enable me to list it for sale this Spring with Stevens Realty. Toward this end, I posted a \$5000 Performance Bond with the City, as required by the Department of Safety Inspections. In early January, we then ordered a completely new Code Compliance Inspection, and hired Victor Vladyka, a licensed general contractor and owner of Allside Construction to oversee the project and perform the repairs remaining on the Code Compliance Report. Victor has assured me that his work can be completed in two weeks. The heating contractor, Forrest Heating, has already completed their work. I have advanced Allside \$1000 to commence their work, and bids for the Electrical and Plumbing work are forthcoming this week. I am requesting that work on exterior stucco be completed when weather permits, and garage repair later in Spring. The Building Permit has been posted at the duplex.

I ask your permission to finally complete this project without any further delays. It's been so close to being finished for quite some time. I have also come to realize that my area of expertise is not real estate or construction and that I should stick with my restaurant equipment business. But I would like you all to view the finished product, restoring an average old East Side duplex into an affordable and beautiful home with lots of quality and character. Thank you. 




