Sorry—I was out yesterday so didn't get this back to you within 2 days.

Regarding 1037 Grand Avenue—the 4 trees on Oxford were trimmed this morning (10/20). We planted two of those trees upon request of the owner between July 2007 & September 2009—I remember because there were street lights there and we didn't want to plant more trees, but he was adamant that we should plant them because he wanted them. The ash trees in the “vicinity” of the property—next door and across Grand—were treated in 2016 to prevent infestation (and subsequent death) of emerald ash borer. There was also a tree planted north of his property in 2013—again “vicinity”. Grand was pruned in 2007.

At 541 Dayton—there are two mature trees. The block was pruned in 2013.

Let me know if you need anything further—not sure if any of this is helpful as some of it is not 2016, but as with most city services—they are performed on a cycle—not every year!
