- 1. Cut and remove tall grass, weeds and rank plant growth from yard, blvd, and alley areas. Comply before July 9, 2018
- 2. Remove improperly stored or accumulated refuse which may include: garbage, rubbish, loose and scattered litter, discarded furniture, appliances, vehicle parts, scrap wood and metal, recycling materials, household items, building materials or rubble, tires, brush, etc., from entire property including yard, boulevard, alley, and driveway.
 PLEASE REMOVE IMPROPERLY STORED OR ACCUMULATED REFUSE WHICH MAY INCLUDE: SCRAP WOOD AND METAL, RECYCLING MATERIALS, HOUSEHOLD ITEMS, BUILDING MATERIALS, RUBBLE, BRICKS, BUCKETS, CRATES, BROKEN FLOWER POTS, BUCKETS WITH STANDING WATER, TREE BRANCHES, BRUSH, ETC., FROM ENTIRE PROPERTY INCLUDING YARD, BOULEVARD, ALLEY, AND DRIVEWAY. If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal **before July 09, 2018**, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes.

<u>Charges</u>: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipments, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260 per hour plus expensed for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN A CRIMINAL CITATION

Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **June 27**, **2018** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

- 1. YARD: The yard lacks proper ground cover. Seed, or sod, where needed to eliminate erosion onto the public sidewalk.
- 2. DECK/STAIRWAY: Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks, railings and handrail in a professional state of maintenance and repair. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Provide a copy of the signed contract showing the start date of your project and estimated completion date.
- 3. EXTERIOR WALLS: The exterior walls of the house has defective or unpainted wood surfaces in the rear of home, second floor. Maintain in a professional state of maintenance and repair. Provide a copy of the signed contract showing the start date of your project and estimated completion date.
- 4. STAIRWAY/SIDEWALK: All sidewalks, walkways and exterior stairs shall be maintained in a professional state of maintenance and repair, free of defects and hazards. Repair or replace the unsafe stairway, walkway, and/or sidewalks in an approved manner to eliminate erosion control and trip hazards. Provide a copy of the signed contract showing the start date of your project and estimated completion date.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after July 31, 2018, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible

abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)
