Dear Mr. Seile:

This is to confirm that our office has received your application for a variance from the city's noise ordinance and that it is being processed.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending that a variance be issued to Become Co/Red Bull for a sound level variance (SLV #3), in order to use a specialized snowmobile on Thursday, February 26, 2015 for Location 4, Ramsey Street Hill, 420 Summit Avenue, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.; and on Saturday, February 28, 2015 for Location 8, Cathedral Hill Park, 215 Summit Avenue, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for a 2015 Red Bull Frozen City Project Event. Noise sources for SLV #3 will be from the specialized snowmobile running for Location 4, Thursday, February 26, 2015 at the Ramsey Street Hill, 420 Summit Avenue, and for Location 8, Saturday, February 28, 2015 at Cathedral Hill Park, 215 Summit Avenue. Conditions will include that the sound sources will be limited to 91 dBA as measured 50 feet from the sound source.

A public hearing on your request for a variance has been scheduled for February 18, 2015, at **5:30 p.m.**, Third Floor, City Council Chambers, at the Saint Paul City Hall/Ramsey County Courthouse, 15 Kellogg Boulevard W., Saint Paul, Minnesota.

You may wish to be present at this hearing to answer any questions that the City Council might have. After the public hearing, the Council may grant, deny, or modify the variance request.
