Victor:

If he is contesting the fact that cigarettes were sold to a minor as well as the \$200.00 fine then **we cannot** go before City Council. We will need to set up a hearing before an administrative law judge instead. If he were admitting to the violation but contesting **only the \$200.00 penalty** then we would set up a public hearing before Council.

It sounds to me like he wants an administrative hearing. If so, we will have to wait to set that up because the Office of Administrative Hearings might be closed due to the State shutdown. We have to wait until after July 1st to see where we stand. Maybe the licensee will be back in the country at that time and can attend the hearing.

I will let you know once we know more.
