

Common Alder
Botanical *Alnus glutinosa*
When Early to mid-winter
How Selectively prune and thin for shape/
branching
Comments Can be pruned in spring, but
will bleed excessively and can stain the
bark

Common Almond, Pink Flowering
Botanical *Prunus glandulosa*
When After blooming
How Tip prune and thin
Comments Encourage thicker, stronger
growth by pruning back 1/2 to 2/3 of each
cane

Common Amur Maackia
Botanical *Maackia amurensis*
When Late-winter through early-spring
How Remove dead, damaged, weak
branches; Selectively prune and thin for
shape/ size
Comments

**Common Apple, Fruiting and
Ornamental**
Botanical *Malus spp.*
When Mid- to Late-winter
How Selectively prune and thin for shape/
branching
Comments Avoid pruning in spring or
summer because of disease transmission
(i.e., fireblight)

Common Apricot, Fruiting
Botanical *Prunus spp.*
When Mid- to late-winter
How Selectively prune and thin for shape/
branching
Comments Avoid pruning in spring or
summer because of disease transmission
(i.e., fireblight)

Common Arborvitae
Botanical *Thuja spp.*
When June, July
How Shape for hedging; thin selectively if
needed
Comments Do not prune back into bare
wood

Botanical *Fraxinus spp.*
When Fall to late-winter
How Selectively prune and thin for shape/
branching
Comments Do not confuse with Mountain
Ash, *Sorbus*

Common Asparagus
Botanical *Asparagus officinalis*
When Fall or spring
How In fall, prune when yellowing after first
hard frost; Cut back to 2" above soil line,
add compost and mulch
Comments Can opt to not prune in fall and
do spring clean up

Common Aspen/ Poplar
Botanical *Populus spp.*
When Late summer through winter
How selectively prune and thin for shape/
branching
Comments Prone to suckering like most
Populus species; Pruning in late summer
through early fall helps discourage sucker
response to wounding

Common Azalea
Botanical *Rhododendron x*
When After blooming in spring
How Tip prune if needed, and cut out any
dead wood
Comments May have to remove 'tiers' to
shape; prune withing 2-3 weeks of flowering

Common Barberry
Botanical *Berberis spp.*
When Early- to late-spring
How Shear or selectively prune for shape
Comments vase-shaped cultivars benefit
from renewal pruning in early spring

Common Bayberry
Botanical *Myrica pennsylvanica*
When Late winter, very early spring
How Selectively prune and thin for shape/
branching

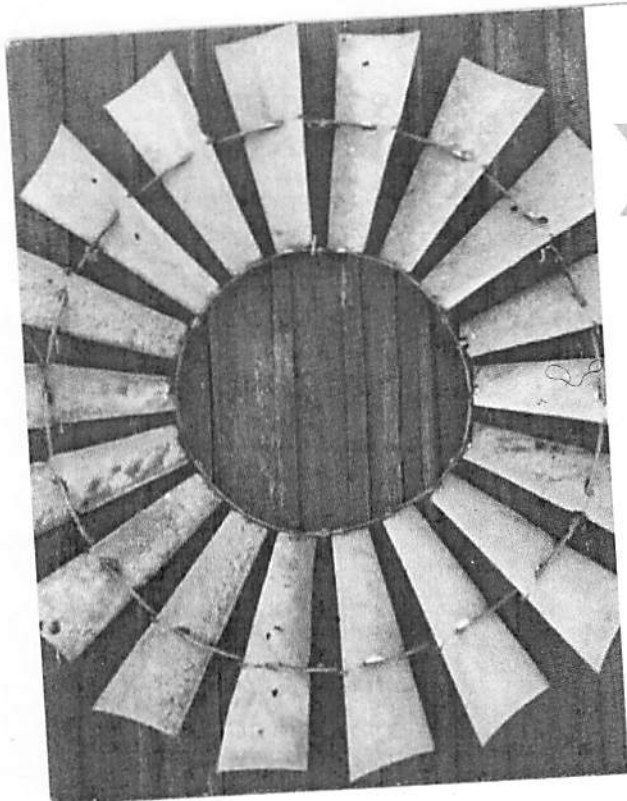
