Dear Councilmember Thune:

The Saint Paul Area Chamber of Commerce (SPACC) writes to express its strong support for the proposed use of 344 Summit Avenue as a boutique hotel. Similar to the city's zoning committee and planning commission, which approved the proposed boutique hotel, we believe this project is good for Saint Paul.

SPACC supports this project for a number of reasons. First, we believe the boutique hotel is consistent with Saint Paul's comprehensive plan. Second, the boutique hotel would be far less intense of a land use than the property's prior use as a visual arts institution. This would provide a public safety benefit by minimizing traffic congestion in the public streets. Finally, we believe the proposed use would enhance the character of the existing neighborhood. In summary, SPACC encourages the city council to uphold the planning commission's approval of this important project. We believe the proposed boutique hotel provides the city with a unique opportunity to expand its tax base through economic development premised on historic preservation.
