As owner or person(s) responsible for: 432 ATWATER ST you are hereby ordered to eliminate all nuisance conditions which are in violation of Chapter 45 of Saint Paul Legislative Code.

Remove improperly stored or accumulated refuse including: garbage, rubbish, discarded furniture, appliances, vehicle parts, scrap wood and metal, recycling materials, household items, building materials or rubble, tires, brush, etc., from yard areas. Remove loose and scattered refuse throughout behind the building.

Cut and remove tall grass, weeds and rank plant growth.

Remove and properly dispose of all animal feces from yard areas.

IMMEDIATELY secure all buildings which are open to unauthorized entry, including:

If you do not correct the nuisance or file an appeal before **June 22, 2015**, the City will correct the nuisance and charge all costs, including boarding costs, against the property as a special assessment to be collected in the same way as property taxes. Charges: If the City corrects the nuisance, the charges will include the cost of correction, inspection, travel time, equipment, etc. The rate will be approximately \$260.00 per hour plus expenses for abatement.

You must maintain the premises in a clean condition and provide proper and adequate refuse storage at all times

If you have any questions about this order, the requirements or the deadline, you should contact the Inspector listed above, Monday through Friday.

Appeals: You may appeal this order and obtain a hearing before the City Council by completing an appeal application with the City Clerk before the appeal deadline noted above or seven (7) days after the date mailed, whichever comes first. No appeals may be filed after that date. You may obtain an appeal application from the City Clerk's Office, Room 310, City Hall, St. Paul, MN 55102. The telephone number is (651) 266-8585. ***WARNING** Code inspection and enforcement trips cost the taxpayers money. If additional new violations are discovered within the next following 12 months, the city's costs in conducting additional inspections at this same location within such 12 months will be collected from the owner rather than being paid by the taxpayers of the city. Appeal to Abatement Order 15-127767

During the week of June 8th, I emailed the City of St. Paul to file a complaint regarding the garbage that was being thrown onto our property on 432 Atwater Street. A Code Enforcement Officer came out to survey the garbage that was being dumped from the sidewalk along Atwater down the hill and onto our property.

We are in the process of updating our building and want to work with the city to improve our side of the street. The first task we undertook was the painting of the building. We requested that the city trim the brush back so we would be able to paint the back side of the building. Instead of trimming the trees, the city chose to remove several trees leaving stumps and some downed brush. They explained that the remaining brush was on our property and that we are responsible for its removal. Since there are no visible property stakes we are unaware of where our property ends and the City's property begins. We have requested, and received approval from the City Engineering Department, to come out and mark the lot lines.

Over the years, we have had various St. Paul citizens choose the rear of our building as their home. They sleep alongside of the building, leave trash, paint graffiti and cook meth. We are trying to clean up our side of the street by repainting our building and installing lights to dissuade people from their activities. Attached are pictures of our side of the street and the south side of Como. While the south side is perfectly manicured our side receives no attention.

As a business resident of St. Paul since 1980, we are hoping to work with the City to beautify both sides of the street. For our effort, we were rewarded with a summary abatement order and instructed to clean up years of debris which originated from City land and was deposited onto our property. In addition, the cleanup is to be completed by June 22nd merely five days after receipt of the letter.

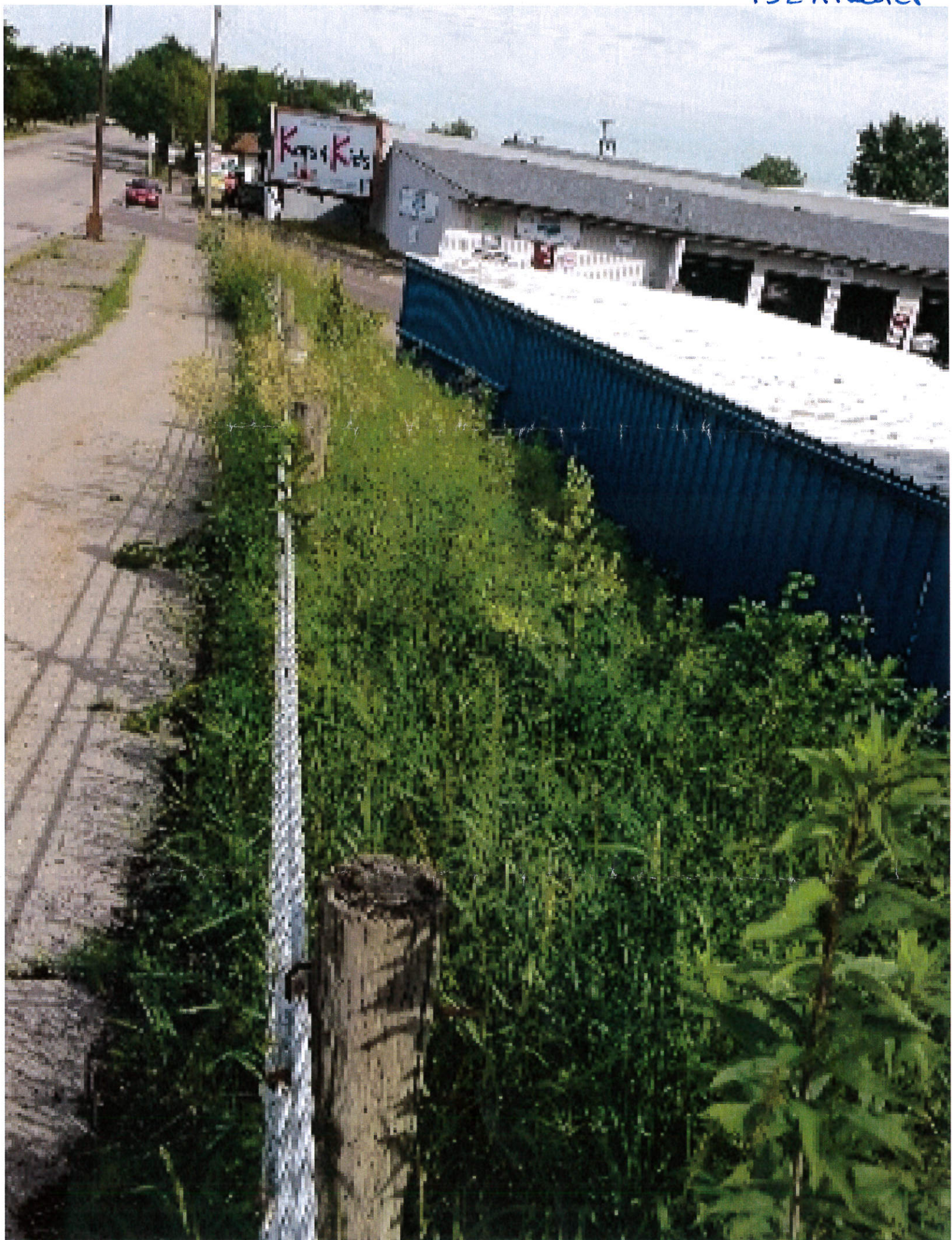

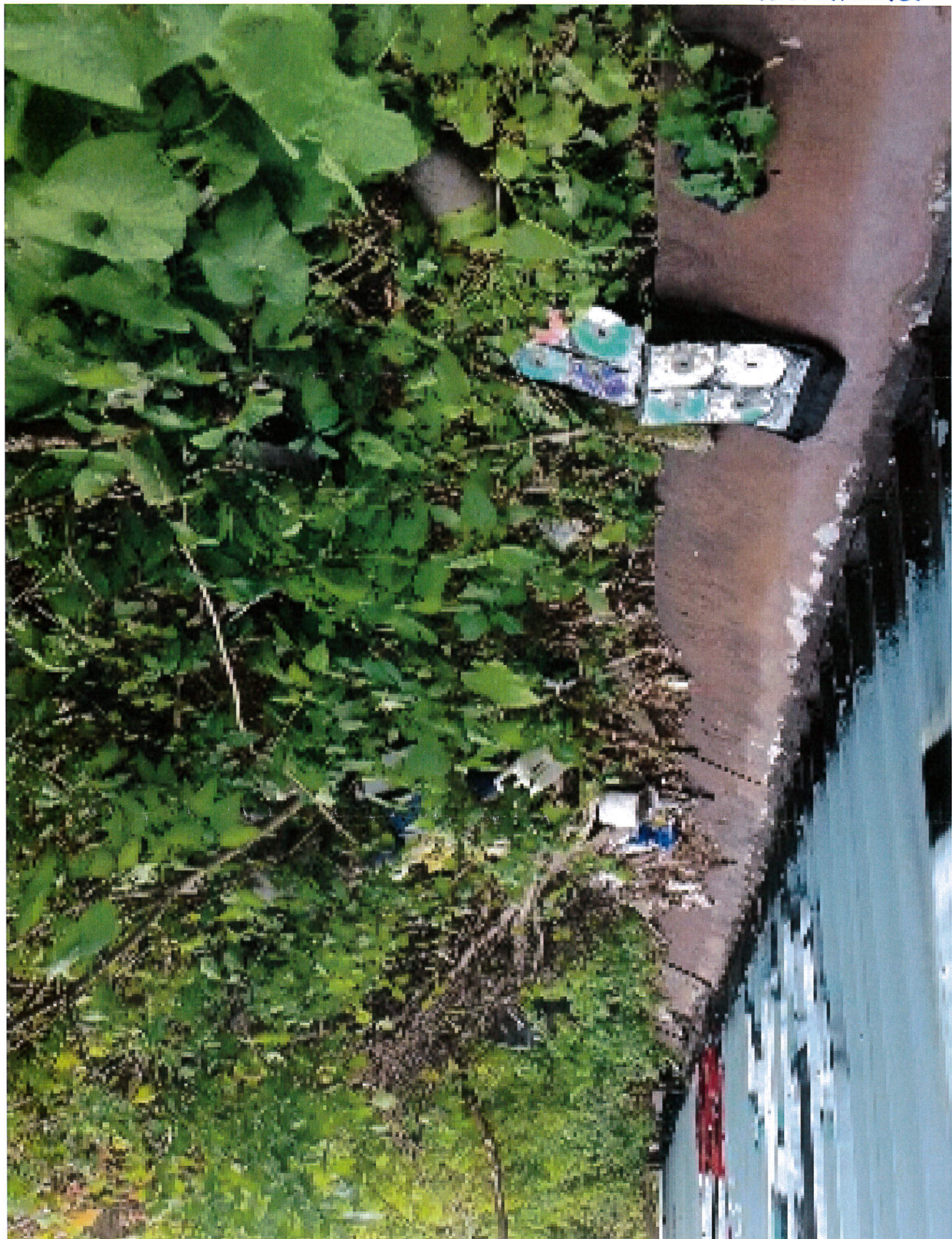
