What Is Being Appealed and Why? *Attachments Are Acceptable*

- Vacate Order/Condemnation/Revocation of Fire C of O Units 1 & 2 have egress windows with ladders permanently affixed to the wall, unit 1 is 12 inches from sill unit 2 is 42 inches.
- Summary/Vehicle Abatement request was made to replace with steps 48 inches from sill, we would like to keep the ladders which is closer to sill allowing easier exit.
- Fire C of O Deficiency List
- Fire C of O: Only Egress Windows Units 1,3 and 5 have double hung windows with openings of 20 inches high X 29.5 inches wide (4.92 sq. ft. opening)

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on December 22, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on February 27, 2012 at 11:30 AM.

Failure to comply by the 2/27/12 re-inspection may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Interior - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.
 - Unit 1 South Bedroom- Double hung egress window measured 17.5 inches height by 29.5 inches width openable space and has a glazed area of 7.5 square feet.
 - Unit 1 North Bedroom- Egress window sill height measured 69 inches from the floor.
 - Unit 2 Bedroom- Egress window sill height measured 57.5 inches from the floor.
 - Units 3 and 5 South bedrooms- have double hung egress windows that measure 17.5 height by 28.5 inches width openable space and have a glazed area of 7.5 square feet.

2. Unit 1 - NEC 408.7 - Unused openings for circuit breakers and switches shall be closed using identified closures, or other approved means that provide protection substantially equivalent to the wall enclosure.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
