



- On average, a national preservation expert/economist (Donovan Rypkema) has found that historic designation makes an area more appealing to homebuyers and increases property values 12%–15% over similar non-designated areas and properties (historic district successes include Summit Avenue, Irvine Park, Lowertown, and Dayton's Bluff).
- Keep a neighborhood's feel and scale intact and can control out-of-scale redevelopment.
- No requirements to change or upgrade a building's existing condition or exterior as a result of an historic survey or designation.
- Historic characteristics are reasonably preserved on a building's exterior with new projects; there is absolutely no impact on interior building projects.
- Preserves certain historic buildings, which are some of St. Paul's most important, irreplaceable assets.
- For some types of historic designation, tax incentives, grants, and other programs may be available for refurbishment projects.
