NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance

Wild Home Opener Hocktoberfest Street Party - Visit Saint Paul

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: 7th Street West between Kellogg Boulevard West (174 7th Street West) and Walnut Street North (258 7th Street West); and for a DJ/live music on Chestnut Street one half block North of 7th Street West and South of Smith Avenue North.

Noise Sources: Visit Saint Paul has applied for a sound level variance in order to provide amplified outdoor music using electronically powered equipment at the recommended locations, times and decibel level limits (dBA) as described: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 2:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. in the street on West 7th Street on October 6, 2018 outside Tom Reid's, 258 7th Street West and at Eagle Street/The Liffey, 174 7th Street West, and a DJ/Live Music on Chestnut Street one half block North of 7th Street West and South of Smith Avenue North during the Wild Home Opener Hocktoberfest Event. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound sources outside on the street from 2:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. on October 6, 2018.
