### Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 947 BARCLAY ST

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 26, 2011, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. BUILDING VACATE DATE IS December 9, 2011 property TO BE vacated BY 12 NOON.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Bathroom SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.-Replace all torn or missing tile.
- 2. Front Door SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.
- 3. Front Porch. SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 4. Front entry way MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove all storage from front entry way.
- 5. House MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Reduce 75%

- 6. Kitchen SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the floor tile. Replace repair all torn or missing tile
- 7. Underneath Kitchen Sink. MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue .Located in basement and through the house.
- 8. Various locations MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 9. Various locations MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 11. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 12. NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.
- 13. SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
- 14. SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.-Chevy truck 153 Ols Cutlass
- 15. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-Replace all broken glass
- 16. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 17. MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 18. MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more
  - Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Measured 20inches openable height and 23inches openable width. Sill 21inches. Glazed 40inches in height by 21inches in width. These are double hung windows.
- 19. SPLC 34.11 (5), 34.34 (2) Contact a licensed contractor to repair or replace the water heater. This work WILL require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-There is an new hot water heater installed without a permit.

20. SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) - Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. Xcel has cut power at the pole. Tenant is using a generator
