I was hoping you could help me with a fire C of O case which is currently under appeal with the City Council where a property owner operates a pallet recycling business. Our Fire Inspector cited his building for excessive storage of pallets. Evidently idle pallets have been identified by the Fire Code as being highly flammable. Anyway, he has made the claim that he would like to considered installing fire sprinklers to make his business more safe, but he was told there is not enough water pressure in our system to support a fire sprinkler system. This has been confirmed from my staff. He has asked me if and when the City will be upgrading/maintaining the water supply to his area so he could plan on installing the sprinklers.

Can you tell me if there is any plan to upgrade the water supply for 391 Topping Street?
