NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVOKE LICENSE

Dear Mr. Suggs:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) will recommend revocation of the MAD-Game Machines (42 @ \$17.00) and MAD – Music Machines (9 @ \$17.00) licenses held by Thomas Suggs d/b/a Jubilee Music Company for the City of Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On January 30, 2014, you were sent a letter and RENEWAL INVOICE from the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) stating your MAD-Game Machines (42 @ \$17.00) and MAD – Music Machines (9 @ \$17.00) licenses expired as of October 31, 2013. You currently owe \$1,215.00 in delinquent license and late fees.

You were also asked to submit the following information with your license payment: 1) list type of machine (snack, pool table, video game, etc...) and location and 2) a copy of your Tax ID or Social Security Number.

You were given until February 20, 2014, to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the required information. As of today's date DSI has not received your license fee payment or the required information.

At this time, you have three (3) options how to proceed:

1. You can pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the required information. If this is your choice, you should send the payment and information directly to the Department of Safety and Inspections, at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday, March 10, 2014**. A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience. Payment of the delinquent license and late fees and submission of the required information will be considered to be a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
2. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by **Monday, March 10, 2014**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to revoke your MAD-Game Machines (42 @ \$17.00) and MAD – Music Machines (9 @ \$17.00) licenses. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
3. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). You will need to send me a letter disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing no later than **Monday, March 10, 2014**. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will then need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

Please note: If you choose an administrative hearing, the Department of Safety and Inspections reserves the right to request that City Council impose the costs of the administrative hearing per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05 (k).

If you have not contacted me or DSI by Monday, March 10, 2014, I will assume that you are not contesting the revocation of your MAD-Game Machines (42 @ \$17.00) and MAD – Music Machines (9 @ \$17.00) licenses. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
