## A reinspection will be made on February 27, 2014 at 9:30 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- Laundry Room MSMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts 1. for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
  - -Dryer vent is not properly vented through the ceiling.
- Unit 5 Entire Unit SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling 2. height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.
  - -The ceiling height of the entire unit is 6ft 8in.
- Unit 5 MN Stat. 299F.362 Immediately provide and maintain a smoke detector located 3. outside each sleeping area.
  - -Dead batteries in both detectors
- Unit 5 UMC 2103 All equipment, appurtenances, devices, and piping must be installed in a 4. workmanlike manner.
  - -The thermostat is not operational.

5. Remove the accumulation of snow or ice from the public and private sidewalk abutting this property.
