Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on January 18, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on February 18, 2011 at 10:45 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. INTERIOR SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Provide a second outlet in bedrooms with only one outlet. This work will require a permit.
- 2. INTERIOR SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.33 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.-There is evidence of a rodent infestation. Professionally exterminate and provide documentation to inspector.
- 3. INTERIOR MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-Provide Carbon Monoxide Alarm within 10 feet of south downstairs bedroom.

- 4. INTERIOR MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Repair broken crank handle on downstairs south bedroom egress window.
- 5. INTERIOR MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information. Upon inspection, double-hung windows in upstairs bedrooms measured 21 inches openable height x 32 inches openable width. Unable to measure windows in downstairs middle bedroom due to obstructions.
- 6. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 7. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
