NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUSPEND LICENSE

Basher Elwagi MNA Food Mart 361 Earl Street St. Paul, MN 55106

RE: Cigarette/Tobacco license held by Elwagie Foods Corp. d/b/a MNA Food Mart for the premises located at

361 Earl Street in Saint Paul License ID #20080000534

Dear Basher Elwagi:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) has recommended suspension of the Cigarette/Tobacco license held by Elwagie Foods Corp. d/b/a MNA Food Mart for the premises located at 361 Earl Street in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On December 1, 2011, a tobacco compliance check was conducted at MNA Food Mart on 361 Earl Street. A seventeen year old male entered your store and asked to buy smokeless chewing tobacco. He was not asked to show his identification, which would have indicated he was underage. Nevertheless, the clerk sold him a package of smokeless chewing tobacco. Sale of tobacco to an underage person is a violation of Minn. Stat. § 609.685 and Saint Paul Legislative Code § 324.07(c).

This is the third (3rd) violation for the sale of tobacco products to an underage person within the past eighteen (18) months; therefore, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §324.11 (b) (1) the licensing office will recommend a thirty (30) day suspension of your Cigarette/Tobacco license.

At this time you have two options on how to proceed:

1. If you wish to admit the facts but you contest the penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by Monday, January 2, 2012. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to impose the thirty (30) day suspension of your Cigarette/Tobacco license. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.

3. If you dispute the facts outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). I will need to receive a letter from you disputing the facts and requesting an administrative hearing by Monday, January 2, 2012. At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation.

If you have not contacted me by Monday, January 2, 2012, I will assume that you do not contest the thirty (30) day suspension of your Cigarette/Tobacco license. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.

Please be advised that the clerk who was identified as having made the sale on this date is also being charged a \$50.00 administrative penalty pursuant to Minn. Stat. §461.12, subd. 3. This is a separate action from this license matter.
