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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Sound Level Variance MNUFC Pre-Season Event

Dear St. Paul Property Owner:

This is to inform you of a request for a variance from the sound level limitations as indicated in the St. Paul Noise Ordinance (Chapter 293 of the St. Paul Legislative Code). Property owned by you and located near the noise source, may be affected by this variance request. Rental property owners must provide a copy of this notice to all renters or post a copy in a common area of the building so it can be viewed by the occupants.

Description of Variance:

Location: 400 Snelling Ave. N.

Noise Source: Zacharia Litzelswope, Director of Events and Guest Experiences, has requested a sound level variance, at a requested sound level limit of 95 decibels (dBA), at no specified distance, to provide the use of a sound system for a DJ and amplified musical performance for the Minnesota United FC Pre-Season Event. The variance is requested for the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 9:30 a.m. on Sunday, February 9, 2020. The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The Variance shall be for the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., with a pre-event sound check at 9:30 a.m. for the Minnesota United FC Pre-Season Event on Sunday, February 9, 2020. 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 95 dBA as measured 50 feet from any sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 6:00 p.m. on the date of the event.
