Dear Property Representative: Building is to be vacated on October 31,2012.

Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on October 8, 2012. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 2. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
