CORRECTION NOTICE - COMPLAINT INSPECTION

Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on July 3, 2018 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on July 10, 2018 at 3:00 PM to verify corrections have been made, or the unit is to be vacated.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Interior Unit 512 SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unfit for human habitation. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.
 - Unit is condemned and may not be used after July 10, 2018 at 3:00 PM if unit is not cleaned out and pest control measures are in place for the unit and surrounding units.
- 2. Interior Unit 512 MSFC 1030.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit path.

 Windows are inaccessible at time of inspection. Personal items, clothing and furniture are in front of windows.
- 3. Interior Unit 512 MSFC 315.3 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials. Piles of personal items and clothing throughout unit. Could not walk through unit without stepping on personal items and clothing.

 Trash bags on floor in kitchen and living room appeared to have been dumped out, fruit flies

thick on food left out.

- Interior Unit 512 MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.
 Couldn't open door fully into unit due to accumulation of debris and personal items. No doors able to open or close to bedroom or bathroom. Could not get near windows in property, personal items and combustibles piled all around the rooms.
- 5. Interior Unit 512 SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.34 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.

 Difficulty getting door to unit open, personal items and trash bags piled up in unit. Fruit flies so thick in unit didn't want to open mouth. All life stages of German cockroach observed, photographs of nymphs, observed adults moving through areas. Kitchen sink full of moldy dishes, black water, fruit flies. Could not move through unit without stepping on personal items left on floor. Flattened cardboard boxes from unit found in hallway, cockroaches observed in hallway and on cardboard. These were removed at inspection.
- 6. Interior Unit 512 and adjacent as needed SPLC 34.10 (6), 34.34 (5) Exterminate and control insects, rodents or other pests. Provide documentation of extermination.- Clouds of fruit flies, difficult to open mouth, breathe without getting them in the mouth. German cockroaches throughout unit, observed all life stages from nymphs to adults with egg cases on back.

German cockroaches observed in hallway due to tenant moving boxes to elevator lobby.
