NARRATIVE

I, squad 140 (A. Larson), was aware that there was a private party at 508 N. Snelling Ave. I had observed several people entering the building and loitering in the front.

At approximately 0100 hours, I had also advised the security (Statewide Protective Agency) that was parked in

front of the entrance that from Sherburne/Fry, I could hear loud music coming from the second floor windows. The security officer, Troy Nadeau (President) was cooperative and notified the inside security. It should be noted that there is outside security (Statewide) and then inside security which is an independent company owned by, Jimmy Dale Gipson (08/12/1970).

At 0151 hours I was driving W/B on Sherburne at Asbury when I observed security officer, Nadeau attempting to break up a fight that was in the middle of the street on Sherburne just east of Snelling. I notified other squads that there was a fight. Security officer detained one of the females involved in the altercation, [REDACTED]. I detained a second female, Kadie Marie Risland (03/25/1991) who was fighting with [REDACTED].

Other squads arrived just as the party was letting out. There was well over 100 people that were leaving the party, and a second fight broke out behind the business in the parking lot. It took several officers to get the crowd to disperse. Many of the occupants were disorderly and swearing at the police. Plastic cups were being dropped on the ground that came from inside the building.

I warned a group of females in a vehicle to leave the area several times. One of the females made a comment that she would hit all of the squads. I advised the female in the passenger seat a second time that she needed to leave the area or I would spray her with ASR. The female, then yelled out the window that I was a rude and disrespectful "bitch" and made a comment about "white people". She continued to yell, I sprayed a short burst of my ASR towards the direction of the female yelling. The female was able to roll up the window, and it did not appear that the ASR made contact with her. The vehicle then left the area, and I was unable to get a plate number.

I then was advised that I needed to take photographs inside the building at 508 N. Snelling. Ofc. Nash monitored Kadie Risland who was in the rear of my squad. I walked in the front entrance. As soon as I got inside, I could smell a strong odor of burnt marijuana coming from inside. It was so strong that it gave me a headache. When I got to the top of the steps I observed plastic cups on the floor, a beer can on a table. Then when I walked towards the rear of the building, near the rear exit, I observed two laundry tubs with melted ice and one empty bottle of wine in the tub. I also observed a cash tray with card playing chips inside, a tip jar, a large cooler, several bottles of booze, a shot glass, several bottles of empty booze in the trash, a wine opener, an ashtray. I took photographs of the items that I observed. While taking photographs, I watched the owner take down a piece of tag board off the front of the bar area and hide it near the DJ booth. I walked over to where he hid the tag board, and found that it was a drink menu written in black magic marker that was taped up so people could order drinks from. I took photographs of the tag board, and also hung it back up where it was hanging originally, so I could take a photo of it.

Ofc Higgins recovered the poster board and turned it into property (See supplement)

I then went outside and spoke with the outside security, Nadeau. He told me that his job was to monitor the exterior of the building and that there was a separate security hired for the inside. Nadeau told me that if there is issues inside, the people are brought outside, and then he deals with the problem. He pointed out a male that was standing on the sidewalk holding a metal wand for weapons, and said that he was the male who provided security inside. Nadeau also stated that the owner (older male, unknown name) was there the entire evening, and he was the one that was advised about the loud music.

I spoke with the male, Jimmy Dale Gipson (08/12/1970) who stated that he was the security officer for the interior of the building. He stated he works independently and receives cash for providing security. He said that two other males assisted him (Tron & Quinn). He said he did not know if that was their real names, and did not know their last names. He said that he did not know if they charged a fee to get inside the building. He said he just wanded individuals when they entered to make sure they did not have any weapons.

I spoke with Tanazia Shree Morehead (03/20/1988) who stated she is the cashier at the front door and she checks ID's. She stated that everyone except a few friends she knows that entered the building provided a valid identification showing they were 21 years of age. The cost to enter the party was 5.00\$ at the door. She stated that there is one other female who helps her out, but was unable to provide a name.

While speaking to Gipson, I observed squad 141 (Ofc. Roettjer), escort a male from the inside of the business and transport him to jail (See supplement).

I then spoke with Kadie Marie Risland, who was the female that was inside the rear of my squad. She stated that she got into a fight with, [REDACTED] because [REDACTED] was hitting her twin sister, Kayla Marie Risland (03/25/1991). She stated that [REDACTED] and her sister are dating, and that there were five girls that went to 508 N. Snelling. She stated that she paid five dollars to get in, and they did not ID her at the door. It should be noted that when I detained Kadie, she did not have any identification with her. She stated she is 20 years old and they served her alcohol. Besides her sister, Kayla (20 years old) her friend Dominique Samantha Harrison (08/22/1990) also entered the party.

I spoke with both Kayla Risland, and Harrison and both individuals stated that neither of them were asked to provide identification. Kadie Risland was cooperative, and provided information when asked. I advised her and released her from the scene.

I then spoke with [REDACTED] who is 17 years old. [REDACTED] was not cooperative and used vulgar language and was screaming and crying uncontrollably. She stated she got into a fight with her girlfriend, Kayla and Kadie then jumped in. [REDACTED] was slurring her words and had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from her breath. [REDACTED] submitted a sample of her breath into a PBT. The PBT registered at a .232 (serial #03293). [REDACTED] lives in Green Bay, Wisconsin and we were unable to get her mother to commute to pick her up. Detox refused to take her, because of her intoxication level, and the fact that she was uncooperative. Sgt Cleveland advised me that we could bring her down to Regions hospital because she was so intoxicated and did not have a guardian that we could turn her over to. I transported, [REDACTED] down to Regions and turned her over to the charge nurse. [REDACTED] was cited for Disorderly Conduct and Underage Consumption (citation #911134664).

It should be noted that there was a shots fired at this location on 06/25/2011 at 0207 hours (See CN-11-128-921). One casing was recovered.

Squad 141 (Roettjer) was sent to 508 Snelling Ave N on the report of a fight. I arrived on scene and several officers were there.

We went into the address at 508 Snelling upstairs where there was a gathering. There were over 100 people inside that left out of the gathering. As we went up stairs people were trying to clean things up and were dumping out alcohol bottles. There was a male there identified by MN ID as (AGWUA PHILIP OMOT DOB 1-1-83, 3040 Sumter Ave Crystal, MN 55427). OMOT said "we have a permit" and pointed to a city of St. Paul License on the wall.

We had received complaints and requests for extra patrol at this address in roll call training. We were told there was a fire occupancy, and there was to be no alcohol served inside. Omot was told they did not have a permit to sell alcohol.

There were two females in a back room trying to dump out alcoholic beverages. I asked them to leave the room. The club owner then came in the back door and claimed he was not there the whole night and was not aware what OMOT was doing. We then saw him go into the other room and was trying to conceal a sign for purchasing alcoholic beverages. Squad 140 (Larson) photographed the sign. SEE REPORT.

Officer Larson stated there were minor girls who were intoxicated and admitted to purchasing alcohol inside the business, SEE REPORT.

Squad 104 (Sgt Cleveland) was speaking with the owner when OMOT came up behind him. OMOT was asked to go and sit down By officer McDonald. OMOT refused to listen to verbal direction. Officer McDonald had to escort him away from Sgt Cleveland.

Omot was then told to have a seat in the chair next to him. OMOT refused and began to walk behind me. Omot then began walking toward a door. I was not sure what was inside the room or if it had been cleared. Omot was becoming more upset and would not listen. I again asked OMOT to sit down and to stay out of the way. OMOT refused and continued walking toward the room.

I then grabbed OMOT by his left hand and placed him into an escort hold. OMOT immediately began to pull away as I escorted him away from the doorway. Omot then brought his arms in to the center of his body and OMOT had not been searched for weapons. Omot was not complying with verbal direction and continued to pull away from me. Officer McDonald grabbed on to OMOT's right hand and we were able to get one hand cuff on him. OMOT then tried to stand up and began twisting his body away from officers as he was trying to escape. OMOT continued to pull away but we were able to push him down on a table. OMOT continued trying to reach his arms in to the center area of his body. I delivered one strike to center part of his leg using my left knee. This strike was not effective. I again delivered a knee strike to the center of OMOT's leg and we were able to get him lower to the table and place the second cuff on. During this arrest my left thumb became pinched between OMOT and his handcuff.

It should be noted officers did recover a small knife in his front pocket that was placed in with his property. I then transported OMOT to the LEC where he was booked for selling alcohol to minors and obstructing legal process.

NARRATIVE

On 07/02/2011 at 0151 hours, I (squad 112/Higgins) heard squad 140 (A. Larson) check out on a fight in front of 508 N. Snelling Avenue. I responded to assist since we have had many problems in recent weeks stemming from 508 N. Snelling including many fights, some involving weapons.

When I arrived there were at least 100 people in the street that began fighting again in the east parking lot behind the building. Another 50-100 people filed out of the business after the second fight was over. I, along with other officers went upstairs to make sure the building was cleared out and to head off any further problems that might arise.

When I got upstairs there were at least 10-15 customers inside the business that had to be told to leave. Two girls were trying to hide in the bathroom when officers arrived.

I looked in the back room (door open) and observed what was obviously an operational bar. There were many empty liquor bottles, a bottle opener, a tip jar with a sign on the front that read "TIPS", and a till drawer under the bar. The till drawer was empty.

As I was looking around the bar area, I heard the rear door open and in walked the owner: OGIAMIEN, Jonah Idehen, B/M, 08/22/1952, 508 N. Snelling Avenue, St Paul, MN 55104, #661-642-1413. I immediately recognized OGIAMIEN as the owner from previous contacts I have had with him. OGIAMIEN has always been very uncooperative in the past. On one occasion we responded to a loud music complaint for his business and he was wanting a search warrant before he would let officers into his business. He also had to be told multiple times to turn the music down before he complied.

On 07/02/2011, OGIAMIEN was not as uncooperative, but seemed more scared that the police were there. I saw OGIAMIEN remove a cardboard sign from the front of the bar (facing the dance floor) and he attempted to surreptitiously hid the sign behind some DJ equipment on the stage. Based on OGIAMIEN'S body language and the evidence that there was an operational bar in an establishment that did not have a liquor license, I assumed that the sign had something to do with liquor sales. The sign was recovered and it was in fact a sign displaying the prices of liquor and beer.

I later property inventoried the sign in PL #11.

NARRATIVE

On 07/02/2011 I, Sgt. John Bandemer, was assigned to do hold book interviews. At about 1130 hrs I interviewed a OMOT, Agwua Philip (DOB 01/01/1983) of 3040 Sumter Ave. N, Crystal, cell 612-554-2779 in the LEC. OMOT was in custody for Obstruction of legal Process and GM Furnishing Alcohol to a Minor while at 508 N. Snelling. The interview was digitally recorded and the recording was later transferred to the Media Vault by me. I read OMOT his Miranda warning per SPPD form PM 247.1 which he initialled and signed indicating he understood his rights. The following is a synopsis of that interview.

OMOT stated that the building at 508 N. Snelling is owned by a friend of his named "Jonah". Jonah had hired OMOT to monitor the activity of the rental hall while the party was going on. Jonah had rented his hall to a man named Mike JONES aka "Milkman" to be used between 2200-0200 hrs. OMOT was supposed to collect the \$400-\$450 from JONES at the beginning of the night, but they made an agreement that OMOT would collect the money at the end of the night. OMOT said that Jonah had hired the outside security person as they usually do, but that he did not know who the security was inside the building.

OMOT said that the security at the entrance door was checking ID's before anyone paid to get into the hall. OMOT said that he did not monitor them to make sure he was doing their job. I asked him if the cash register was at the door or the bar area and he said it was at the door, but it did not belong to the hall, it was brought in with the party. I asked him about the grease board that had the prices of the drinks on it and he said that it was also brought in by the people who were running the party.

I asked OMOT about the permit for the hall. He said that Jonah has a permit to rent the hall. I asked if that permit allowed him to sell or allow alcohol in the hall and he did not know the answer.

Other statements that OMOT made during the interview:

- he was not drinking alcohol during the night
- Jonah was at the hall during the night, but he wasn't sure if he was there at the end of the night
- JONES was also there during the party and OMOT saw him talking to officers at the end of the night
- OMOT thought there were between 100-150 people in the hall at any one time
- even though there is air conditioning in the hall it was a very warm night and was very hot in the hall
