Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 10, 2012, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on October 22, 2012 at 11:30 am or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Lower Unit Basement SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner. Repair or replace damaged ceiling tiles.
- 2. Lower Unit Basement MSFC 605.1 Remove unapproved exposed wiring and install in accordance with the electrical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Repair the loose hard-wired smoke detector in utility room and secure to the junction.



Lower Unit - Basement - SPC 4715.1430, & 1440 - Provide approved support for all plumbing piping.

WOT ON IT

Lower Unit - Throughout - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) - Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner. Repair damaged area of floor on basement stair landing.
 Repair damaged and loose carpet throughout.
 Repair damaged transition areas.

- 14. Upper Unit 3rd Floor SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition. Repair door at the top of the stairway.
- 15. Upper Unit 3rd Floor MSFC 315.2 Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials.

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16. Upper Unit - Throughout - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) - Repair and maintain the walls and ceilings in an approved manner. - Scrape and paint throughout as necessary wherever chipped or peeling. Repair all cracked, damaged and loose plaster as necessary.
