I would like to appeal the determination that the window sizes in the second floor north east bedroom are in-adequate to provide foster care within my home.


There are four of the said windows with a openable area of 20.5 inches high by 30 inches wide. The size of the window openings exceed the statute that states the windows should be a minimum of 24 inches high by 20 inches wide. Please notice the picture provided below of these 4 windows. As you can see, these windows are simply "turned sideways" in that the openable area is wider rather than higher.

**Required: 24" by 20" = 480 square inches of openable area**

**Current, existing windows: 20.5" by 30" = 615 square inches of openable area**

### DEFICIENCY LIST

1. \*BEDROOM EGRESS WINDOWS - OPENABLE DIMENSIONS - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information. **The second floor north east bedroom has four windows all with openable dimensions of 20.5 inches high by 30 inches wide.**
