Dear Ms. Wagers, Mr. Alton, Mr. Stadstad & Mr. Wagers:

Legislative Hearing was conducted on May 14, 2019 before Marcia Moermond, Legislative Hearing Officer, and she recommended that the City Council grant 180 days for the nuisance building to be abated by razing and removal or rehabilitation, as evidenced by issuance of a Certificate of Code Compliance.

There will be a Legislative Hearing scheduled for **Tuesday**, **November 26**, **2019 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 330 City Hall (this was rescheduled from November 12 per request)** at which DSI staff will present information on the current building conditions and progress toward abatement of the nuisance conditions.

If you have received your Certificate of Code Compliance by November 26, 2019, this hearing will be cancelled and a resolution will be forwarded to the City Council indicating the nuisance conditions have been abated and the matter is closed.

If you have *not* received your Certificate of Code Compliance by November 26, 2019, you will need to contact Joe Yannarelly (joe.yannarelly@ci.stpaul.mn.us or 651-266-1920) to schedule an

inspection to occur *prior to* the week of November 26, 2019. Both Mr. Yannarelly and a building inspector will conduct this inspection to determine percentage of completion.

The findings of the Legislative Hearing will be considered at a City Council Public Hearing on Wednesday, December 4, 2019 at 3:30 p.m. in City Council Chambers, Room 300 City Hall, 15 West Kellogg Blvd., Saint Paul.
