My name is Gretchen Long. I am the owner of and reside at 506 Robert St S – the property MnDOT will aquire as part of this project.

I'm writing today in support of the project and to convey my thanks and appreciation for the efforts and consideration the MnDOT team has shown me, especially Chris Bower.

First, this project is desperately needed. My property overlooks the intersection of Robert St and Cesar Chavez. I witnessed accidents at this intersection within the first month I moved in 10 years ago, and I've seen many more since then. The most concerning development I have seen over those 10 years ago is the increase in the speed of the vehicles travelling through the intersection, and an increase in confusion about how to navigate the intersection. Both of these contribute to making an already difficult intersection even more dangerous. They have shown concern not just for me, but for the entire community. Their goal is a project and process that respects everyone who is impacted. I believe they will succeed, and, in doing so, make this a better community.

I urge the council to consent to the project and allow it to move forward for the safety and wellbeing of all those impacted.
