Your building was inspected on May 21, 2019, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A reinspection will be made on June 21, 2019 at 1:00pm or the property vacated.

Owner removed occupant from the building during inspection.
