There is a large hill above street level, where the building and yard is located. Keeping the rubbish and recycling bins up multiple steps and at rear of the building is not practical when the bins would have to be moved, weekly, to the boulevard for pickup - especially if rubbish and recycling dates vary. The bins will be very heavy, and it would be unreasonably burdensome to have to bring them from the rear of the building, down multiple steps to the boulevard, then reverse that process, every pickup date.

Leaving the bins permanently on the boulevard has been done for over 100 years. Other properties also on the North side of Acker St. W. have the same dilemma. Applicant requests the ability to continue the 100 plus year history of keeping the bins on the boulevard in front of the building

CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **March 21, 2019** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

1. **GARBAGE STORAGE:** Garbage containers cannot be stored on the boulevard/public sidewalk/street except on the day of collection. Immediately cease storage of containers on the boulevard/public sidewalk/street. **TRASH AND RECYCLING BINS MUST BE STORED BEHIND THE FRONT OF THE HOUSE. PLEASE REMOVE THE BINS FROM THE STREET AND BOULEVARD AND STORE IN AN APPROPRIATE LOCATION. THANK YOU.**

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after **March 28, 2019**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. **Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges²** and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)

- ² Criminal charges can be brought on the day the violation is observed, but generally we allow time to correct unless this is a repeat violation.

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WARNING: Code inspection and enforcement trips cost the taxpayers money. If the violations are not corrected within the time period required in this notice, the city's costs in conducting a reinspection for compliance after the due date will be collected from the owner rather than being paid for by the taxpayers of the City. If additional new violations are discovered within the next following 12 months, the city's costs in conducting additional inspections at this same location within said 12 months will be collected from the owner rather than being paid for by the taxpayers of the City. Any such future costs will be collected via assessment against the real property and are in addition to any other fines or assessments which may be levied against you and your property.

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
