Noise Source: Hmong American Day Committee (Fiscal Agent: American Legion 3H Post 1975) has requested a sound level variance to present amplified music and the use of a sound system for announcements, speeches, dances and live musical performances from 10:00 a.m. (Pre-Event Sound Check at 8:30 a.m.) until 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 14, 2015 at Harriet Island.

The Department of Safety and Inspections will be recommending the following conditions: 1) The variance shall be for the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. for the Hmong American Day Event on Thursday, May 14, 2015. 2) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers, or similar devices will only be located at the locations indicated on the venue diagram submitted as part of the sound level variance application: a. Wigington Pavilion Indoor Stage B and b. Stage Outside of the Wigington Pavilion Stage A and those used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured at 50 feet from the sound source. 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment to ensure compliance with the sound level variance conditions. 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 9:00 p.m. on May 14, 2015.
