A re-inspection was made on your building on August 4, 2017, in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiencies must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on or after September 6, 2017.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior Alley Side SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-8989. Maintain Park in the rear of the building.
- 2. Exterior Building SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.33 (1) b, c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. Paint peeling throughout the fascia/soffits, window frames.
- 3. Exterior Property SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, retaining walls, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. Retaining wall.
