Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 16, 2019, or the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 40.06 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on November 1, 2019 at 12:30 PM or the property immediately vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. SPLC 34.09 (1)(2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Mortar missing, paint peeling and deteriorated wood surfaces.
- 2. SPLC 34.08 (3) Provide and maintain suitable ground cover on all exterior areas to control erosion.-Ground next to eastside public sidewalk has washed away and is undermining sidewalk.
